

Your horse has received joint injections. The joints were injected under strict sterile technique and then were wrapped (where possible) to prevent contamination. If present, the wraps can be removed after 3-4 hours. Your horse should be kept in a clean environment for the next 24 hours.

If injected with steroids or hyalouronic acid they should be off work for the next 3 days. After this they can be returned to light work for 7 days and then can continue their regular work routine.

If injected with Noltrex they should be off work for the next 3 days. After this they can be returned to low impact (light) work for 7 days and then they can slowly return to their regular work routine over the next 2 weeks.

You horse was given an injection of flunixin meglumine by intravenous injection after their joint injections. This will help reduce pain and inflammation associated with the procedure. This does not need to be repeated.
